The first day candidates may circulate nominating petitions for the Board of Trustees' election is September 20, 2022. The first day candidates may file their nominating petitions is Monday, December 12, 2022. Nominations must be filed by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, December 19, 2022. Nominations may be filed during the following times:
