ISU Social Work Program Requirements

Students are admitted to the program for the fall semester only. To be considered for admission, students must have a minimum GPA of 2.50, complete at least 45 credit hours of college coursework prior to enrollment, and earned a grade of C or better in all courses required for the major.

The following courses are required for admission:

- Introduction to Social Work (Sauk's SOC 200) with a grade of "C" or higher
- One Human Biology Course (Sauk's BIO 103 or BIO 120) with a grade of "D" or higher
- One statistics course (Sauk's MAT 240) with a grade of "D" or higher
